Introduction

Following the appointment of the Executive Board at the 2019 WFTGA Convention in Tbilisi in Georgia, the new EXBO members are coming into their own, each contributing positively to their positions and portfolios within the EXBO.

We have continued working at ensuring that the organisation meets the regulations of an NPO and the related governance requirements. Members/Industry meetings and WFTGA Representation


