Why We Need You?

While our International Training Centre in Nicosia, Cyprus has been a cornerstone of excellence over the years, one training location is simply not enough. There are talented, passionate tourist guides in **Africa, Southern and Latin America, and Asia** who lack access to training due to geographical and financial barriers. We need partners—dedicated members and stakeholders —who can host in-person training courses and make a lasting contribution to the development of the tourist guide profession and tourism sector.

Can you host a WFTGA Training Course?

We are open to offers from partners and stakeholders, who share WFTGA's non-profit, capacity building ethos of empowering local tourist guides and supporting them to become strong voices within the global forum of professional tourist guides.

If you share this ethos, here are a couple of **points to consider for hosting a WFTGA Training Course**:

- Accessibility through flight and transport infrastructure as well as visa requirements
- Affordability for course participants in the region, including sponsors
- Access to heritage assets for guiding practice
- Strong, well-connected Tourist Guide Association and active WFTGA member
- Administrative capacity and English-language skills
- Existing team of WFTGA Trainers or commitment to building such a team
- Local partnership network for support and in-kind contributions

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What are your tasks?

- activate your local network and source affordable
 - o and suitable course venue as well as accommodation for participants and trainers
 - o local transport for transportation, where necessary, and guiding practice
 - o access to a site (museum, gallery, archaeological site, place of worship) for guiding practice
 - o refreshments for course participants and trainers
- provide a cost breakdown for the above services
- lend expertise of local tourist guides and assist the WFTGA Trainers in developing a guiding route on a moving vehicle, a walking route and a site guiding module for the course
- do what you do naturally: extend your hospitality to the course participants and WFTGA Trainers in preparation and during the course

How will WFTGA support?

- galvanise the global WFTGA network and communication channels to publicise courses
- manage the selection and recruitment of course participants
- assist with budget planning and financial administration, e.g. collect payments from participants
- send international WFTGA Trainers to deliver courses, in collaboration with local WFTGA Trainers
- carry out examination and assessment
- award certificates, in collaboration with local educational partners where they exist
- undertake course evaluation
